Fáilte ar ais / Welcome Back

Is fada, fada an lá ach táimid faoi dheireadh thiar thall in áit le fáilte ar ais a chur roimh na daltaí s'againn uilig ar bhonn lán-aimseartha. Cé nach bhfuil a fhios againn cad é a tharlóidh amach anseo, tá mé cinnte go n-aontóidh tú nach mór do na páistí teacht ar ais an t-oideachas s'acu a atosú in áit níos foirmealta na tábla na cistine.

Ar dtús báire, áfach, ba mhaith liom buíochas a ghabháil libh as an tacaíocht a thug sibh don scoil agus don obair chrua a chuir sibh isteach le míonna anuas ag deimhniú gur lean na páistí leis an fhoghlaim, ach ag deimhniú chomh maith nach raibh tionchar dochracha ag an phandéim ar an fholláine mhothúchánach s'acu. Is é an tosaíocht s'againn ná na páistí a chur ar a suaimhneas go mbeidh siad slán ar scoil agus táimid muiníneach go ndaingneoidh na socruithe atá curtha in áit againn an teachtaireacht sin.

Tá súil againn go gcuirfidh an leabhrán seo sibh, mar thuismitheoirí, ar bhur suaimhneas go bhfuil gach rud in áit againn le sábháilteacht na ndaltaí a dheimhniú agus iad ar ais ar scoil. Tá na socruithe atá leagtha amach sa leabhrán seo bunaithe ar Threoirlínte ar an Lá Scoile Nua ón Roinn Oideachais (RO), a foilsíodh ar an Déardaoin 13ú Lúnasa, atá ar fáil ar líonláithreán na scoile. Glac an t-am leis an leabhrán seo a léamh, le do thoil, na Socruithe Ginearalta agus na codanna a bhaineann le rang/anna do pháiste/pháistí ach go háirithe.

Faoi dheireadh, gabh i dteagmháil liom ar an fhón, ríomhphost nó Whatsapp dá mba mhaith leat gné ar bith de na socruithe don Lá Scoile Nua i nGaelscoil Uí Néill a phlé.

It has been a long, long time but we are finally in a position to welcome all our pupils back to school on a full-time basis. While we do not know what the future holds, I am sure you will agree that the children need to come back and resume their education in a more formal setting than the kitchen table at home.

First of all, however, I would like to thank you for the support you have shown to the school and the hard work you have put in over the last few months in ensuring that the children continue to learn, but also in ensuring that the impact of the pandemic has not had an adverse impact on the children's emotional well-being. Our first priority will be to reassure the children that they will continue to be safe in school and we are confident that the measures we have put in place will reinforce that message.

This booklet will hopefully reassure you, as parents, that we do, indeed, have everything in place to ensure the children's safety back at school. The measures outlined in this booklet are based on the Department of Education (DE) Guidelines on The New School Day, published on Thursday, 13th August, which is available on the school website. Please take the time to read the appropriate sections of this booklet, most notably the General Arrangements and the sections relating to your child's/children's class/classes.

General Arrangements

Dian-ghlanadh

Rinneadh dian-ghlanadh ar fad ar an scoil le míonna anuas agus, mar a fheicfidh sibh nuair a thagann sibh ar ais, bhí meitheal tuismitheoirí ag obair go dícheallach thar an samhradh leis an taobh amuigh den scoil a mhaisiú a bhí de dhíth go géar. Míle buíochas ollmhór dár Meitheal Tuismitheoirí.



Éide Scoile

Molann Treoirlínte an RO nach gcaitheann na páistí na héadaí céanna dhá lá i ndiaidh a chéile:

Cé go dtig leis an Choróinvíreas fanacht ar éadaí ar feadh tamaill, níl riosca ard ann i scoileanna agus cé go bhfuil sé molta <u>go gcaitheann páiste éide glan nó éadaí úra gach lá</u>, níl sé seo riachtanach agus ba chóir do scoileanna bheith airdeallach ar an phobal scoile s'acu agus gan a thuilleadh brú/caiteachas a chothú do thuismitheoirí.

Cé gurbh fhearr linn go gcaithfeadh na páistí na héidí scoile gach lá, iarraimid oraibh a dheimhniú go gcaitheann do pháiste éide glan nó éadaí úra gach lá, le bhur dtoil.

larraimid oraibh a bheith airdeallach ar riachtanais leithris na bpáistí agus sibh ag roghnú éadaí don lá, na páistí óga ach go háirithe, i.e. jíons le cnaipí casta, riteoga, bróga le Velcro srl. Tá sé ríthábhachtach go mbíonn neamh-spleáchas ag na pástí lena gcuid éadaí féin, arís eile na páistí óga ach go háirithe, mar is maith an seans nach mbeidh a fhoireann in ann cuidiú leos.

Trealamh Scoile

larrtar ar na daltaí gan a dhath a thabhairt ar scoil leo (ach amháin do bhuidéal in-athúsáidte ar Lá 1 – féach thíos): níl mála scoile, cás peann luaidhe, liathróid nó rópa scipeála de dhíth. Soláthróidh muid gach rud atá de dhíth ar na páistí le linn an lae. Arís eile, tá sé se i líne le Treoirlínte an RO.

General Arrangements

Deep Clean

The school has undergone a very deep clean over the last few months and, as you will see when you come back to school, a number of parents have worked diligently in the evenings throughout the whole summer to give the outside of the school a much-needed make-over. School Uniforms

DE Guidelines encourages pupils not to wear the same clothing to school on two consecutive days:

While Coronavirus can land on fabrics and remain for some time, schools are not a high risk environment and while <u>all children and where possible young people should be encouraged</u> to wear clean uniform or fresh clothes each day, this is not essential and schools should be mindful of their school community and avoid creating additional pressure / expense on parents.

While we would prefer the children to wear their uniforms on a daily basis, we would ask you to ensure that children do indeed wear clean uniform or fresh clothes each day, please.

We also ask that you are mindful of the children's toileting requirements when selecting clothes for the day, especially the younger children, when selecting clothes for them for school i.e. jeans with tricky buttons, tights, Velcro footwear etc. Independence at managing their own attire is very important, especially for the younger children, as staff may not readily be able to help them with such adjustments.

School Equipment

The pupils are asked not to bring any equipment whatsoever (except for reusable water bottle on Day 1 – see below): no school bag, no pencil case, no footballs or skipping ropes. We will provide everything the children need throughout the day. Once again, this request is in line with DE Guidelines.

Dátaí Tosaithe

Beidh dhá amanna fágála againn ar maidin:

- larrtar go bhfágfaí daltaí le sloinne a thosaíonn le A M ar scoil idir 9.00am 9.15am.
- Iarrtar go bhfágfaí daltaí le sloinne a thosaíonn le N Z ar scoil idir 9.15am 9.30am.

Seans go mbeidh solúbthacht againn leis na hamanna seo, gabh i dteagmháil liom dá mba mhaith leat seo a phlé.

Ní thig linn ligean do dhuine ar bith teacht isteach sa scoil roimh 9.00am.

Bolgóidí Ranga

Tá cead ag tuismitheoirí tiomáint isteach sa scoil go fóill ach iarrtar orthu fanacht sa charr ar fad. I ndiaidh dóibh tuirlingt, treorófar na páistí caol díreach chuig an seomra ranga, mar a mbeidh an múinteoir ag fanacht leo. Iarrfar orthu a lámha a ní sula dtéann siad isteach sa rang.

Le linn an lae, fanfaidh na páistí i mBolgóid Ranga, i.e. ní mheascfaidh siad ach leis na páistí óna rang féin le linn an lae. Beidh tábla an duine ag gach páiste agus beidh an chathaoir s'acu 1 méadar ón chéad suíochán eile. Beidh stáisiún oibre an mhúinteora suite 2m ó chathaoir an pháiste is cóngaraí.

Torthaí agus Uisce

larraimid ar dhaltaí buidéal ólacháin in-athúsáidte a thabhairt leo ar an chéad lá scoile. Bheimis fíor-bhuíoch dá scríofá ainm do pháiste ar an bhuidéal seo i marcóir buan de bharr go gcoinneoidh do pháiste an buidéal seo ar scoil amach anseo agus é a líonadh ó sconna an ranga gach maidin. Nífidh na cúntóirí na buidéil i Rang 1 agus 2 agus is iad na daltaí féin a nifidh iad i Rang 3 – 7, mar chuid den chlár ar shláinteachas pearsanta. Olfaidh na páistí sa Naíscoil as cupáin indiúscartha.

Don sos, iarrtar ar na daltaí toradh úr nó triomaithe a thabhairt leo mar smailc.

Am Sosa

Beidh sos 10 mbomaite ag gach páiste idir 10.30am agus 11.15am. Ní úsáidfidh muid an clós tosaithe mar spás súgartha a thuilleadh agus roinnfear an clós cúil ina dhá zón súgartha, le 1m eatarthu, rud a dheimhneoidh go bhfanann gach rang ina mBolgóid Ranga. Ar an drochuair, ní thig linn trealamh súgartha a chur ar fáil do na páistí ag an am seo.

Starting Dates

- Primary 7 pupils will return to school on Monday, 24th August
- Primary 1 6 pupils will return to school on Tuesday, 1st September
- The first group of Naíscoil pupils will come in on Monday, 7th September.

Staggered Drop-off

We will have two drop-off times in the morning:

- Children with surnames beginning with A M are asked to be dropped off to school between 9.00am 9.15am.
- Children with surnames beginning with N Z are asked to be dropped off to school between 9.15am 9.30am.

There may be some flexibility with these times, please contact me if you would like to discuss this arrangement.

We cannot allow any access to the school before 9.00am.

<u>Classroom Bubbles</u>

Parents are still permitted to drive into the school grounds but are asked to remain in the car at all times. On alighting, the children will be directed immediately to their classrooms, where their teacher will be waiting. They will be asked to wash their hands before going into the classroom.

Throughout the day, the children will remain in their Classroom Bubble, i.e. they will only mix with children from their own class throughout the day. Each child will have their own desk and each seat will be placed 1 metre from the next. The teacher's work station will also be placed 2m from the nearest child's chair.

Fruit and Water

We ask that pupils bring a reusable drinking bottle on the first day of school. We would be very grateful if you would write your child's name on this in permanent marker as your child will keep this bottle in school for the foreseeable future and fill it in the morning from the kitchen sink. The classroom assistants will wash the pupils' bottles from Rang 1 and 2 regularly and the children themselves from Rang 3 – 7 will wash their own regularly, as part of our personal hygiene programme. Pupils from the Naíscoil will be provided with disposable cups.

For their breaks pupils are permitted to bring fresh or dried fruit for their morning snack.

Break-time

All children will have a 10-minute break between 10.30am and 11.15am. We will no longer use the front yard as a play space and have divided the back yard into two play zones, with a 1m buffer zone between them, this will ensure that each class stays within their Classroom Bubble. Unfortunately, we cannot provide play equipment for the children at this time.

Am Lóin

Gheobhaidh na páistí béile the go fóill ag am lóin. Tá £2.60 ar lón sa Ghaelscoil agus tá £2.50 ar lón sa Naíscoil. Tá am ar leith tugtha do gach rang le dul chuig an halla leis an lón a ithe. Ní bheidh ach rang amháin sa halla ag aon am amháin. Ar mhaithe leis an teagmháil le dromchlaí a laghdú, ní bheidh rogha dinnéir ag na daltaí sa chéad chúpla mí mar go n-iarrfar orthu dul caol díreach chuig an tábla agus tabharfar an dinnéar chucu (cuirfear biachláir amach go breá luath).

Is iad na hamanna lóin mar a leanas:

- Rang 1 11.45am
- Rang 2 12.00pm
- Rang 3 12.15pm
- Rang 4 12.30pm
- Rang 5 12.45pm
- Rang 6 1.00pm
- Rang 7 1.15pm

Glanfar na tablaí go mion idir gach seisiún.

larrtar ar na daltaí a thugann lón pacáilte leo é a thabhairt i mbosca lóin de phlaisteach crua, i gcomhair leis an deoch lóin s'acu. Glanfaidh na daltaí an bosca lóin seo mar chuid de Chlár ar Shláinteachas Pearsanta de chuid na scoile. Tabhair faoi deara go mbeidh rochtain ag gach páiste, iad siúd a ghlacann lón pacáilte san áireamh, ar uisce úr sa cheaintín ag am lóin. Ofrálfar bainne do na daltaí a ghlacann dinnéir scoile chomh maith.

I ndiaidh lóin, beidh súgradh 20 bomaite ag na páistí sa Zón Súgartha beartaithe s'acu, nó rachaidh siad ar ais chuig an rang má tá sé ag cur.

Airgead Dinnéir

larraimid oraibh airgead dinnéir na seachtaine a chur isteach ar an Luan i gclúdach, marcáilte leis an méid airgid atá sa chlúdach agus cé acu laethanta a mbeidh siad ag glacadh dinnéar, le bhur dtoil. Ná tugtar airgead chuig an oifig, go raibh maith agaibh.

Am Baile

Féach socruithe na ranganna áirithe thíos maidir leis na hamanna tógála ach, go ginearálta, iarrtar ar thuismitheoirí fanacht sa charr agus tabharfar na páistí chucu ag am baile. Maidir le tuismitheoirí a shiúlann ar scoil, fan ag geataí na scoile agus tabharfar na páistí chugaibh.

Lunch-time

The children will still be able to avail of a hot meal at lunch time. The cost for school dinners is £2.60 in the Gaelscoil and £2.50 in the Naíscoil. Each class has been allotted a time where they will go to the hall to eat their lunch. Only one class at a time will be in the school dining hall. In order to minimise the children's contact with surfaces in the school canteen, the children will not have a choice for school dinner in the first few months as they will be asked to go directly to their tables in the hall, with school dinner being brought to them (menus will be issued well in advance).

The times for lunches is as follows:

- Rang 1 − 11.45am
- Rang 2 12.00pm
- Rang 3 12.15pm
- Rang 4 12.30pm
- Rang 5 12.45pm
- Rang 6 1.00pm
- Rang 7 1.15pm

The lunch tables will be cleaned thoroughly between each sitting.

Children bringing packed lunches with them are asked to bring it in a hard plastic lunch box, along with their lunch-time drink. The children will clean their lunch equipment at school as part of our Personal Hygiene Programme. Please note that all children, including those who take lunches, will have access to fresh water from the canteen at lunch-time. Pupils taking school dinner will also be offered milk.

After lunch, the children will have 20-minutes play in their allotted Play Zone in the back yard, or will return to the classroom if it is raining.

Dinner Money

We ask that you send in the week's dinner money each Monday in an envelope, marked with the money contained in the envelope as well as which days the child is taking dinners, please. Please do not bring dinner money to the office, thank you.

Home-time

See each class' arrangements below regarding specific pick-up times but, in general, parents are asked to remain in their cars and the children will be brought to them at home-time. With regard to parents who are walking to school, please remain at the school gates and the children will be brought to you.

Ag Ní na Lámha

larrfar ar na páistí na lámha a ní ag na hamanna a leanas:

- An chéad rud ar maidin
- Roimh am sosa
- I ndiaidh am sosa
- Roimh am lóin
- I ndiaidh am lóin
- Roimh am baile

Beidh díghalraí lámha ann i ngach seomra agus iarrtar ar gach páiste gan a gcuid féin a thabhairt isteach.

Obair Bhaile

Ní bhfaighidh na páistí obair bhaile pháipéir faoi na socruithe reatha, ach cuirfidh gach múinteoir obair bhaile dhigiteach ar fáil le linn roinnt seachtainí i ndiaidh do na páistí socrú ar ais isteach ar scoil.

Club Bricfeasta agus Tír na nÓg

Ar an drochuair, níl muid in ann na seirbhísí seo a chur ar fáil i láthair na huaire ach déanfaidh muid ár seacht ndícheall iad a shocrú chomh luath agus is féidir.

Cumarsáid leis an Scoil

Ní thig linn rochtain ar an oifg a cheadú mar a rinne muid roimhe seo, Cuir scairt ar Marie san oifig le socruithe a dhéanamh maidir le cumarsáid riachtanach a dhéanamh maidir leis na daltaí, le bhur dtoil. Ar an téad chéanna, cuirtear scairt ar an oifig le coinne a dhéanamh le cúrsaí a phlé leis an mhúinteoir nó leis an Phríomhoide, le bhur thoil.

Bus Scoile

Chuir muid in iúl don ÚO nach dtig linn glacadh le daltaí roimh 9.00am.

Tinneas

Má tá do pháiste tinn, impímid oraibh í/é a choinneáil sa bhaile. Má thagann tinneas ar pháiste ar scoil, tá oifig an Phríomhoide beartaithe againn mar sheomra feithimh atá róthinn don scoil. Tabharfaidh ball foirme cúram dó/di go dtí go dtagann tuismitheoir/cúramóir. Más amhlaidh an cás duitse, cuirfidh muid scairt ort agus iarrfaidh muid ort teacht agus í/é a thógáil. Nuair a thagann tú ar scoil, fan ag na geataí agus cuir scairt gútháin agus tabharfar do pháiste amach chugat.

Hand-washing

The children will be asked to wash their hands at the following times:

- First thing in the morning
- Before break-time
- After break-time
- Before lunch
- After lunch
- Before home-time

Each class also has hand-sanitizers and pupils are asked not to bring in their own.

Homework

The children will not receive paper homework under the current arrangements, but each teacher will provide digital-based homework within a few weeks of the children settling back in to school.

Breakfast Club and Tír na nÓg

Unfortunately, we are not in a position to provide these services at the minute but will strive to do so at the earliest opportunity.

Communication with the School

We cannot allow access to the school office as we have done in the past. Please phone Marie to make any arrangements re essential communication about the pupils, please. Similarly, contact the office for an appointment to discuss any issue concerning your child with the class teacher or the Principal.

School Bus

We have informed the EA Transport Service that we cannot accept children travelling to school on the Killen bus to arrive before 9.00am.

<u>Illness</u>

If your child is ill, we urge you to keep her/him at home. If a child becomes ill while at school, we have designated the Principal's Office as the waiting room for a child who is too unwell for school. She/he will be taken care of there by a member of staff until the parent/carer arrives. If this is the case for your child, we will phone you and ask you to come and collect her/him. When you arrive at school, please remain at the school gates and phone the office, your child will then be brought to you.

Clúdacha Aghaidhe

Molann an RO a leanas maidir le clúdacha aghaidhe:

Mar gheall ar na socruithe atá in áit ag scoileanna le leathnú COVID-19 a laghdú ní mholtar clúdacha aghaidhe don ghnáth-úsáid i scoileanna. B'fhéidir gur mhaith le baill fhoirne agus na daltaí iad a úsáid le linn an lae agus is féidir glacadh leis seo. Ní mór do scoileanna bheith airdeallach nach gá do dhaoine áirithe (páistí san áireamh) clúdacha aghaidhe a chaitheamh.

larraimid ar thuismitheoir ar bith a thugann cuairt ar oifig a scoile, i ndiaidh coinne a dhéanamh le Marie, go gcaitheann siad clúdach aghaidhe, le do thoil.

Siomptóimí Covid-19

Cuireann treoirlínte faoi láthair in iúl go gcaithfidh páiste ar bith a léiríonn comharthaí Covid-19 (casacht leanúnach, teocht ard srl.) agus iad ar scoil dul caol díreach chun an bhaile agus go gcaithfidh siblíní dul abhaile fosta. Tá súil is againn nach mbeidh seo amhlaidh do dhalta ar bith againn, ach rachaidh muid i dteagmháil leat má tá muid buartha ar bhealach ar bith

Go ginearálta, seo moltaí an RO maidir le Covid-19:

- má tá siomtóimí agat nó teist dhearfach, beidh ort fanacht sa bhaile ar feadh 10 lá ar a laghad;
- má chónaíonn tú le duine a bhfuil siomtóimí nó teist dhearfach aige, beidh ort fanacht sa bhaile ar feadh 14 lá ón lá a tháinig na siomtóimí ar an chéad duine sa bhaile;
- má fhorbraíonn tú siomtóimí le linn an seal 14 lá seo, beidh ort féin-seiceáil a dhéanamh de réir treoirlínte Teist agus Aimsigh agus fanacht sa bhaile ar feadh 10 lá ón am a chéadthosaigh na siomtóimí (is cuma cén lá as an 14 ar a bhfuil tú);
- muna bhfuil teocht ard agat 10 lá i ndiaidh na siomtóimí, ní gá duit féin-scaradh a dhéanamh.
 Má tá teocht ard agat go fóill, coinnigh leis an fhéin-scaradh go dtí go bhfuil do theocht normálta arís. Ní gá duit féin-scaradh a dhéanamh má tá casacht agat ar feadh 10 lá de bharr gur féidir go mairfeadh casacht roinnt seachtainí i ndiaidh don ionfhabhtú críochnú;
- is dócha go n-ionfhabhtóidh daoine sa teach céanna a chéile nó go bhfuil siad ionfhabhtaithe cheana féin. Laghdóidh an méid daoine eile sa phobal a fhaigheann é go mór má fhanann tú sa bhaile ar feadh 14 lá.

An Curaclam

Cé gur bhreá linn dul ais chuig an gnáth-theagasc agus an bhearna fhoghlama atá ann mar gheall ar na míonna roimhe seo a dhruidim, is é an phríomh-thosaíocht a bheidh againn sna seachtainí agus míonna romhainn ná nósanna nua scoile a bhunú leis na páistí: scaradh sóisialta, sláinteachas lámha. Sláinteachas anála agus an gá le haghaidh noirm nua ranga i.e. ag fanacht ina suí, lámha suas, ag fanacht go foighdeach leis an mhúinteoir, scaradh sóisialta ón mhúinteoir srl.

Chomh maith leis sin, beidh muid ag díriú ar fholláine mhothúchánach na bpáistí i ndiaidh ar tharla agus plé a dhéanamh ar an dóigh ar athraigh an domhan go tobann, cad é mar a

Face Coverings

DE recommendations regarding face coverings in schools is as follows:

Given the risk mitigations in place in schools to limit and contain the spread of COVID-19, face coverings are not generally recommended for routine use in schools. Staff and pupils may wish to use them during the routine school day and this is acceptable. Schools should also be aware that some persons (including children) are exempt from wearing face coverings.

We ask that any parent visiting the school office, having made an appointment with Marie beforehand, would do so wearing a face covering, please.

Covid-19 Symptoms

Current guidelines stipulate that any pupil who shows signs of Covid-19 (persistent cough, high temperature etc.) while at school must go home as soon as possible and that all siblings must also go home too. We hope and pray that this will not be the case for any of our children, but will contact you immediately if we have the slightest suspicion.

In more general terms, DE recommendations re Covid-19 are as follows:

- if you have symptoms of coronavirus or a positive test, you will need to stay at home for at least 10 days;
- if you live with someone who has symptoms or a positive test, you will need to stay at home for 14 days from the day the first person in the home started having symptoms;
- however, if you develop symptoms during this 14-day period, you will need to self-check in accordance with Test and Trace guidance and stay at home for 10 days from the day your symptoms started (regardless of what day you are on in the original 14-day period);
- 10 days after your symptoms started, if you do not have a high temperature, you do not need to continue to self-isolate. If you still have a high temperature, keep self-isolating until your temperature returns to normal. You do not need to self-isolate if you just have a cough after 10 days, as a cough can last for several weeks after the infection has gone;
- it is likely that people living within a household will infect each other or be infected already. Staying at home for 14 days will greatly reduce the overall amount of infection the household could pass on to others in the community.

The Curriculum

While we are very keen to 'normal' return to teaching and to closing the learning gap that the last few months will no doubt have widened, our main priority over the first weeks and months will be to establish the new school routines with the children: social distancing, hand hygiene, respiratory hygiene and the need for new classroom norms i.e. remaining seated, hands-up, waiting patiently, social distancing from the teacher etc.

As well as this, we will also be focussing on the children's emotional well-being after what we have all been through and discuss how the world has changed so suddenly, how they feel

about it, how they have been dealing with it and what support they need moving forward. We will continue to deliver the curriculum as best we can, but it will take a while before we can get back to anything resembling the 'old normal' in the classroom.

Supporting Your Child before Returning to School

Here are a few ways you can help your child get ready to come back to school:

- Revisit the importance of washing hands thoroughly.
- Revisit cough etiquette, most notably the Vampire Cough, coughing into one's elbow joint.
- Social distancing letting them know that they must try to stay 1m from other children and 2m from adults.
- Inform them that there will be no physical contact at school, no hugging or touching.
- Practise their independent self-help skills, putting on and tying shoes (if no Velcro available), coats, jumpers etc.

Unfortunately, we cannot allow parents to enter the Naíscoil building this year.
